- 4) Choose placement testing (this is found on the middle of the page in purple)
- 5) Choose “click here” on #3
- 6) On this page you will find the study guides for the ASSET test. The ASSET test is a paper test that is timed. Students will be given **25 minutes** for each test: math, reading and writing. At the bottom of this page you will find a link to the study guides for the COMPASS test. The COMPASS test is a computerized test and it is **not timed**.

- Students can view the study guides for the **ASSET test**. Choose the level of math that you would like to study and view/print the study guides. The reading/writing study guides are available on-line.

Placement Testing Policies

Official photo identification is required. Students will not be allowed to test without proper identification.

Students who bring their own calculators will have them inspected by the Test Administrators

Students will adhere to maintaining a quiet test environment. Students will refrain from talking with anyone other than the Test Administrator. Disruptive behavior is **not** tolerated.

Students need to understand that children and other adults are **not** permitted in the Testing Center.

Personal items (including, but not limited to book bags, purses, cell phones and pagers) will be placed in an area designated by the Test Administrator.

All cell phones and pagers **will not be permitted** in the Testing Center.

Surfing the web or accessing personal e-mails is prohibited while taking the COMPASS Placement Test.

Students need to understand that if the Test Administrator notices any questionable mannerisms or the appearance of cheating, the Test Administrator will notify the student and the On Site Director of Advising. The consequences will then be determined by the director.
