

2010 Advanced Placement Results Andover Schools

172 Advanced Placement exams were taken in May 2010 by Andover students. Sixty-three percent of the Andover students received a passing grade of 3 or higher out of a possible score of 5. This is well above the state and national average. Advanced Placement courses are highly rigorous courses designed to prepare students for college. In most cases, passing scores on the AP test earn students college credit, college placement, or both.
