## 3rd Grade Classroom Rules

1. **Be attentive** ~ Listen and follow directions.
2. **Be kind and polite** ~ Do not hurt anyone. Treat others as you would like to be treated.
3. **Be respectful** ~ Respecting others includes working quietly so they can learn. Respecting yourself means always doing your best. Respecting our schools means following the rules of the school.
4. **Be prepared** ~ Come to school ready to learn at all times.

\* These rules apply to all areas of the school (playground, CAMP, Library, bathrooms, hallway, cafeteria, etc.)

Third graders will carry a conduct card in their agenda book. For each rule infraction the card will be marked with a number showing the rule that was broken. At the end of each week those with seven or less marks will have a Fun Friday in their classroom. The conduct cards will be sent home on the last day of the week, and will need to be signed and returned the following Monday.



## 3rd Grade Subject Areas

### Rotation

Third graders will be rotating between classes for Science, Reading, Math and Social Studies. This will allow us to differentiate instruction to meet the needs of all students.

### Math

We use the Everyday math curriculum. Each student will complete daily assignments in a math journal. Students will have homework 3-4 times a week called a "Home Link."

Before each unit an Everyday Math newsletter will be sent home that includes a preview of the upcoming unit along with the "Home Link" answer key.

### Reading

We will be using a basal reader for our weekly stories. Students will also have the opportunity to participate in Accelerated Reader. We will encourage students to reach independent and classroom goals. They will be able to earn quarterly rewards by taking an active roll in the AR program. We highly recommend reading a minimum of 20 minutes each night.

In science we will be focusing on:

### Social Studies

Our lessons will be based on:

- Geography
- History
- Government
- Communities / Cultures
- Economics

### Spelling
