

Preliminary Boundary Recommendations

Group #1

1. Elementary boundaries do not have to follow secondary boundaries. Movement needs to take place before 6th grade. (2)
2. Rent BCC space at AHS. Also allow AMS students to use gained space (2).
3. Open enrollment to move 100+ kids. Elementary only? K-8?
4. PS – Just allow AHS to grow.

Group #2

1. Do nothing. Table all talk for two years. (11)
2. Voluntary Shift from North to South. Use lottery system if needed (7).
3. Consider turnpike (I-35) division between North and South, for middle and high schools. Rearrange elementary as needed. Not immediate, grandfather in and push out for 2+ years.

Group #3

1. Do nothing for next 2-3 years. It will show more growth needs as the economy stabilizes (9)
2. Review logical boundary lines. For example Mystic Point and Stonebridge are closer to Meadowlark but they are in the Cottonwood attendance area (1)
3. Voluntary In-District Transfers with Adm. Approval and Guidelines (10)

Group #4

1. Turnpike North/South Divider (3)
2. Do nothing with North/South Divider but adjust some North side elementary schools. (2)
3. New Developments be assigned to schools in need of growth. (5)
4. 2013-2014 earliest Implementation date for all recommendations.

Group #5

1. No Boundary Change. Move all FAA South (Elem, MS, HS)
2. New neighborhoods could be fluid based on building capacities (7).
3. Status Quo (No Changes) (3).

1. **No Boundary Changes at This Time – Total Votes 23**
 - Do nothing. Table all talk for two years. (11)
 - Do nothing for next 2-3 years. It will show more growth needs as the economy stabilizes (9)
 - Status Quo (3)

2. **Allow Voluntary Transfers to Balance Enrollment – Total Votes 17**
 - Voluntary In-District Transfers with Adm. Approval and Guidelines (10)
 - Voluntary Shift from North to South. Use lottery system if needed (7).
 - Open enrollment to move 100+ kids. Elementary only? K-8?

3. **Balance Enrollment by Reassigning New Neighborhoods – Total Votes 12**
 - New neighborhoods could be fluid based on building capacities (7).
 - New Developments be assigned to schools in need of growth. (5)

4. **Use the Kansas Turnpike as the North/South Boundary Line – Total Votes 8**
 - Turnpike North/South Divider (3),
 - Consider turnpike (I-35) division between North and South, for middle and high schools. Rearrange elementary as needed. Not immediate, grandfather in and push out for 2+ years. (5)

5. **Adjust Some Boundaries to Balance Enrollment – Total Votes 5**
 - Do nothing with North/South Divider but adjust some North side elementary schools. (2)
 - Review logical boundary lines. For example Mystic Point and Stonebridge are closer to Meadowlark but they are in the Cottonwood attendance area (1)
